It was difficult because every time that I would get hurt, I would have to either go to the hospital or stay home for weeks. I used to walk up to the balcony of the hospital and kind of see life just go on without me. Kids would be going to school, people going to work, traffic, and I was stuck in the hospital. But that didn't slow me down. Hemophilia wasn't for me like a barrier. I always wanted to keep trying everything. Before I used to treat myself on demand, but you don't know if you're going to have a big bleed or not. It was real challenging. I almost missed my second daughter's birth because of hemophilia B. I got hurt real bad. I waited a few days to go to the hospital to see if it was going to be a severe bleed or not. Literally, my wife was holding herself out for her water not to break because she was going to go to one hospital, and I was in another hospital because of hemophilia B. So something clicked, and I realized that I needed to start treating myself before the bleeds, not after the bleeds, preventing the bleeds, because it was not only about me, but it was about my family. I always wanted to be ahead of the game, and I heard about a product coming up that potentially can last for 10 days or more. It all depends on how your body will react. I was really excited about it. I immediately got in touch with my doctor, and I told him I wanted to try the treatment that I heard about which he told me was called ALPROLIX. Since I've been on ALPROLIX, I had no bleeds or hospitalizations. I encourage other people to talk to the doctor to learn more about the treatment options. I always wanted my daughters to play soccer. My oldest daughter Melissa, she was not into it. But my youngest daughter, Isabella, she was into it. I was her first coach. My philosophy, it was always that, win or lose the games, to have passion for the game like I do. **NARRATOR:** Indications: ALPROLIX® [Coagulation Factor IX (Recombinant), Fc Fusion Protein] is a recombinant DNA derived coagulation factor IX concentrate indicated in adults and children with hemophilia B for on-demand treatment and control of bleeding episodes, perioperative management of bleeding, routine prophylaxis to reduce the frequency of bleeding episodes. Limitation of use: Alprolix is not indicated for induction of immune tolerance in patients with hemophilia B.

**Important Safety Information:** Do not use ALPROLIX if you are allergic to ALPROLIX or any of the other ingredients in ALPROLIX.

Tell your healthcare provider if you have or have had any medical problems, take any medicines, including prescription and non-prescription medicines, supplements, or herbal medicines, have

any allergies and all your medical conditions, including if you are pregnant or planning to become pregnant, are breastfeeding, or have been told you have inhibitors (antibodies) to Factor IX.

Common side effects of ALPROLIX include headache, abnormal sensation in the mouth, and pain in your side with blood in your urine, which may be a sign of clot formation in the urinary collecting system. These are not all of the possible side effects of ALPROLIX. Talk to your healthcare provider right away about any side effect that bothers you or does not go away, and if bleeding is not controlled using ALPROLIX.

Allergic reactions may occur with ALPROLIX. Call your healthcare provider or get emergency treatment right away if you have any of the following symptoms: hives, chest tightness, wheezing, difficulty breathing, or swelling of the face. Your body can also make antibodies called "inhibitors" against ALPROLIX, which may stop ALPROLIX from working properly.

ALPROLIX may increase the risk of formation of abnormal blood clots in your body, especially if you have risk factors for developing blood clots. Call your healthcare provider or seek emergency care if you have symptoms of a possible abnormal blood clot, which may include: chest pain, difficulty breathing, unexpected swelling of an arm or leg with or without pain or tenderness.
